NOVICE CLASS: A Novice dog is one that has not been awarded two novice wins or a place in an open trial.

Once the series has commenced the dogs will maintain the status they started with throughout the winter.

PRIZES: There will be an aggregate award at the end of the series (Surrey, Sussex and Wessex trials only) for those dogs gaining the most points throughout the series.

There will be a championship trial at the end of the series (Surrey, Sussex and Wessex only) where those dogs who have been placed in the first three will be able to compete.
