RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The rules and conditions will be similar to those of the International Sheep Dog Society.
- 2 Any dogs injuring a sheep will be disqualified and the handler shall pay the damage.
- 3 Any objections shall be lodged with the Secretary in writing on the day of the trial together with a deposit of £5.00. The deposit will be returned if the objection is found to be justified.
- 4 The organisers will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident on the trial ground including injury to spectators, competitors, their cars, dogs or property.
- 5 Any competitor failing to run on time may forgo their run.
- 6 No competitor shall approach the Judge during the progress of a trial.
- 7 That any handler entering trials and repeatedly not turning up will lose their automatic right to an entry form.
- 8 The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without giving reason.
- 9 The committee reserves the right not to award any trophy if in their opinion a sufficiently high standard is not attained.
- 10 The committee's decision shall be final on all matters and their decision in respect of objections concerning a run will uphold that of the Judge.

The organisers will not be responsible for any loss or accident on the ground, including injury to spectators, their dogs or property. Cars are parked at their owners' risk; no liability will be accepted in respect of loss of, or damage to cars or contents.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

* Please report to the course director upon your arrival to declare the dogs you will be running, whether Novice or Open, and also to receive a **VOUCHER FOR A FREE SHABDEN PARK FARM BACON SANDWICH.**

Tea, coffee and cakes can also be purchased from the handlers' marquee.

This will be a very public event. There will be a farmers' market in the farm yard as well as other farm animals for the public to see. Local crafts including stick making and leatherworkers are also expected.

Please keep your dogs away from the livestock and produce areas.

DIRECTIONS: The trial will be signposted off the A217.

Via M25 - From Junction 8 at Reigate turn off the M25 and take the A217 towards Sutton. At the 2nd roundabout turn right for Mugswell & Chipstead. Continue straight on (along White Hill) until you reach the junction. Turn left. The farm entrance is on the left hand side opposite the cricket/sports club.

Via M23 - on M23 continue across the M25 and turn left at the first traffic lights into Star Lane, which is the second turning on the left after the end of the dual carriageway. Take the left fork at the top of the hill and after approx 100yds go straight on at the crossroads at the war memorial (Hogscross Lane). Turn right. The farm entrance is on the left hand side opposite the cricket/sports club.
