 Competitors with three dogs must be on the field and prepared to run one dog by 9.30am.  
 Competitors with two dogs must be on the field and prepared to run one dog by 10.30am.  
 All Competitors to be on the field by 12 noon when a draw will take place for the remaining dogs.

## **Directions to the Venues**

### ***May and August Trials, The Copse, Priors Dean***

The trial is situated in the picturesque lanes of Hampshire. You will need to turn left or right off the A32 (depending on the direction you have come from) I believe this is signposted to Petersfield, Froxfield or Steep. Travel up the hill and at the crossroads turn left to Colemore at the fork keep right, travel down the hill and the field is on the left.

### ***May and July Trials, Manor Farm, Didling***

The trial will be signposted off the A272 between Midhurst and Petersfield.

3. Any dog that injures a sheep shall be disqualified and the owner held liable for damages.
